

California Department of Transportation Updated Transition Plan for Pedestrian Rights of Way:

As a part of the implementation of the settlement, Caltrans has completed an updated Transition Plan for the pedestrian rights of way under its jurisdiction. Caltrans assessed its 4,000 miles of sidewalks and crosswalks throughout the state and identified over 30,000 non-compliant locations, all of which are included in the Transition Plan.
