

**ARE YOU A PURCHASE COLLEGE STUDENT OR VISITOR
WITH A MOBILITY DISABILITY WHO HAS FACED ACCESS
BARRIERS ON CAMPUS PATHS OF TRAVEL?**

Your rights may be affected by a proposed settlement if you are:

- A Purchase College student or visitor to the Purchase College campus with a mobility disability (a wheelchair user, person who uses other mobility aids, or person with disabilities that impact their ability to walk distances or climb stairs but who do not use any mobility aid) and
- Have faced accessibility barriers in the paths of travel on the Purchase College campus

In 2016, a lawsuit called *Westchester Independent Living Center (“WILC”) v. State University of New York, Purchase College* was filed against Purchase College, alleging that Defendants denied students and visitors with mobility disabilities meaningful access to the educational, cultural, and social programs, services, and activities offered at the College because of accessibility barriers on the campus paths of travel.

In 2021, the Parties reached a settlement of the lawsuit under which Defendants agreed to remediate accessibility barriers on the Purchase College campus.
